

# FLOEW MEMORIZATION PLAN

**FLOEW stands for: the First Letter Of Every Word.** This plan is actually fairly simple, once fully understood! Then, a person uses it with memorizing cards they make themselves, or they pay us or others to make for them.

FLOEW memorizing still takes time, depending on one's natural abilities and motivation. Yet it gives it a straightforward plan, making it less frustrating. You may ENJOY memorizing!

## EXAMPLE (Article I of the Bill of Rights)

Front of card *[TEXT]*

**Amendment I Congress shall make no law respecting an establishment of religion, or prohibiting the free exercise thereof; or abridging the freedom of speech, or of the press; or the right of the people peaceably to assemble, and to petition the Government for a redress of grievances.**

Back of card *[FIRST LETTERS]* then *[PHRASE FIRST LETTERS]* then *[DOT PATTERN]*

**A1 Cs mnl rae or, op tfet; oa tfos ootp; otr otp pta, atp tG farog.**

*[FIRST LETTERS]*

**(A-)(C- m-- r-- o-)(o- t---)(o- t--- o---) (o-- o-- p--)(a--- t- f----)**

*[PHRASE 1st LETTERS]* Note: this step has parenthesis in harmony with the next step dot pattern.

*[DOT PATTERN]*

## Explanation of Example: The Four Steps of Memorizing

**STEP 1** -- This step is to look back and forth at the front side *TEXT*, and the *FIRST LETTERS* until the text can be quoted easily by just looking at the *FIRST LETTERS*.

Example: "**Congress shall make no laws**" is said by seeing: **C s m n l** (first letters of words in the phrase)

**STEP 2** -- This step is to look back and forth at the *FIRST LETTERS* and the *PHRASE FIRST LETTERS* until the text can be quoted by just looking at the *PHRASE FIRST LETTERS*.

**STEP 3** -- This step is to look back and forth at the *PHRASE FIRST LETTERS* and the *DOT PATTERN* until the text can be quoted easily by just looking at the *DOT PATTERN*.

**STEP 4:** -- This step is to look back and forth at the *DOT PATTERN* and away from the card until the text can be quoted easily by just imagining the dot pattern as one quotes.
