SECTION 167 – April 2, 1991

...

5 Behold, I again give unto you instruction concerning the laws of marriage, and this because of the actions of some of My servants.

6 For some have chosen a woman at will to be unto them as a wife. Behold I say unto you that this is error.

7 For a woman in Israel must choose the man by the Spirit of revelation, and this I have before instructed thee.

8 For I will give unto her a sign and witness, and there is no other way that a man in Israel shall take unto himself a wife.

9 For are ye not Israel, and are ye not the beginning of the gathering of My scattered nation?

10 And am not I your Savior, restoring the laws of Israel that ye may again live them accordingly, that ye may again be acceptable unto Me?

11 For if ye live not these laws, will I not surely leave thee unto your own devices to be cast aside as dross?

12 For it is expedient that ye be instructed in these matters that ye be not led astray into forbidden paths.

SECTION 51- December 1979

My son, thus saith the LORD, even Alpha and Omega, yea even Jehovah who calleth forth His elect that they may gather together to My holy places and be prepared for the burning that soon cometh.

SECTION 68 – April 24, 1981

...

11 For I have appointed thee and called thee to be a prophet unto these people, and as they have ignored thee, so also shall I ignore their pleas in the day of visitation.

12 For they call upon Me with their lips, but they know Me not, for they seek after the things of the earth, and not My will saith the LORD.

13 And they shall be left without root or branch if they repent not, and they shall seek comfort from Me and find it not.

14 And then shall they marvel and lose faith, for I will not heed their prayers, for they heard Me not when I called to them by My servant, whom I called and appointed, but sought after those that spoke pleasant things to them, praising them for their works, which works are putrid before My face.

Even so, Amen.

SECTION 91 – March 13, 1985

...

68 Oh, let the wise hear the words of My voice, even the voice of Jehovah, and heed and prepare themselves that they be not wanting on that day.

69 Oh the daughters of Zion who have polluted their inheritance, who have bowed down to Baal and worshipped the beast and mammon, who have sold themselves for naught, their reward shall be the whirlwind, and their cup the cup of bitterness.

SECTION 74 – January 1982

...

8 And unto the women I have given the sign and witness, for this identifyeth the true seed of Israel.

9 For none who are not of the house of Israel and of the chosen seed shall receive this sign, for it is given unto My people only.

10 Yet none of the women have stepped forth who are willing to keep all of My commandments, except My maidservants Barbara and Opal, and even they understand not all that is required of them and they hesitate in their deliberations.

11 For a woman must be obedient in all things to be found worthy to bear the chosen race.

12 Yet I have decreed in My heart that I will bring forth this generation that will keep all of My commandments, even if they learn obedience by what they suffer.

13 For it is the woman's responsibility to teach the children the gospel, and it is the man's responsibility to teach the woman, that all things be in order.

...

22 And a sign and a witness shall not be given unto a woman until she repents, and when she repents My Spirit cannot be restrained for it is her right.

23 And if she receives a witness and later turns from it because of sin and the fear of being ridiculed, behold I say unto you, she shall be turned over to the adversary that perhaps she may learn by what she suffers.

Even so, Amen.

SECTION 71 – September 22, 1981

...

8 But behold, who will listen to My servants when those whom they call have an overabundance of goods, and they are comfortable in their houses?

9 What must I do to cause My people to repent? Must I take from them their luxuries and comforts and fine apparel, and even humble them to the earth? Then will they heed My word?

10 Behold I say unto you, it is better for a man to come before Me in his prosperous circumstances than when he is humbled by the wrath of Mine anger, for his faith is then based upon love rather than fear.

11 Such will receive a much greater reward in My kingdom

12 Nevertheless, My heart is open to all men if they truly repent, even if it is because of what they suffer.

SECTION 75 – January 13, 1982

...

18 And he shall teach his daughters concerning the signs, that they make no covenant with others that is not by a sign, and witnessed by My Holy Spirit.

19 And if they make covenants that are not by Me or by My word, or in other words, by revelation, they shall not have the promises as mentioned in Section 132 of the Doctrine and Covenants.

Even so, Amen.

SECTION 224 – February 15, 2002

...

7 And in many ways I am pleased with the righteous efforts of My maidservants, who have come of age;

8 Yet they err in one thing, for they disregard the promptings of My Spirit, that I have given to them from time to time to seek after a sign and witness of My Spirit for those to whom they belong to in this life, and in the life to come.

9 For they have felt comfortable in neglecting this, saying that perhaps the Lord desires them to delay this matter, and in this they do err.

10 For I say unto them that if they continue to ignore these promptings further, they shall begin to be tempted, and be led astray into forbidden paths.

11 For is it not a wonder how many are led to lie and cheat and deceive, to embrace the arms of the wicked, yet treat My servants with disdain and a cold and unloving heart.

12 For it is the purpose of the adversary to present before My maidservants all the alternative choices they are faced with, even different paths of faith, enticing careers in Babylon, lustful; and beguiling men, imaginative fantasies, and even the devotion to animals;

13 For if they ignore the guidance of My servants, they shall indeed be given their hidden desires, even as My Maidservant _____ and My maidservant _____, for have I not given both of them their hidden desires?

14 For have they not chosen rags instead of the beautiful garments of the holy Priesthood, and shame instead of glory?

SECTION 146 – August 1988

My son, I your LORD cannot bring to pass Zion until I have a people prepared to accomplish the things I have commanded.

2 For there is not yet one family, yea even one man and one woman that have prepared themselves.

3 For what can a man accomplish in the eternities without the woman who has completely repented and placed herself under My will?

4 For they cling to their material possessions, and they cling to those who will bring them to destruction.

5 For have I, your Savior, not said while I was yet on this earth that unless ye leave father, mother, husband, wife, brothers, sisters, friends and even your children for My name's sake, ye are not worthy of My Kingdom, and cannot enter therein?

6 Yea, many will say that this is a hard saying, and will rebel against it, for they will cling unto the evil and reject the good, for they have not the Spirit.

7 For those who are willing to leave all for My name's sake shall be rewarded in this life a hundredfold, and in the world to come, Eternal Life.

8 And woe unto those who pity themselves for this saying, changing its meaning to bring remorse upon themselves without cause.

...

28 Yet I find not yet one of the daughters of Adam that will serve Me; for not one of My maidservants is willing to totally submit herself unto My will, to raise up unto Me a righteous generation-- yea, even a generation that will seek only My will.

29 For they leave not the dead who have forsaken Me for the things of this world, yea even their father, mother, sisters, brothers, friends, possessions, earthly obligations and covenants, but cling unto them rather than unto Me their LORD and Savior.

30 And they accept unto themselves a false sign and witness and at the end will be turned away.

Even so, Amen.

SECTION 48 – October 13, 1979

...

25 For all women are to step forth who hath had a sign and a witness as to who their husband should be.

26 And when this shall be done by a sign and a witness, to this shall be added the confirmation of the holy Priesthood to confirm again that which hath been received by the woman, that confusion reigneth not, and to expose those who receive not a sign and a witness, and say that they have done so.

27 For My house is a house of order, saith the LORD.

28 And when they have thus received a sign and a witness, they shall be united by My holy Priesthood and live according to the laws of the gospel as contained in the scriptures as pertaining to man and wife.

29 And whom God hath joined together, let no man tear asunder.

30 And let those united in this manner sin not, for have they not come before Me and have received confirmation and revelation concerning this matter?

31 And whichever is more or less than this is sin.

SECTION 69 – July 1981

...

5 For if a revelation is from Me, it shall bring comfort to the righteous and rebuke the wicked.

6 It shall instruct, guide and direct those who desire to live My commandments, or it shall give instructions to the individual that will guide that person to the Eternal worlds.

7 Yea, and the prophecies it contains shall surely come to pass.

8 Without this Spirit the person is left to his own, to kick against the pricks.

9 Such are those who disobey My word through the prophet.

10 Behold there is not one, no not one, who does not now fear to keep all My commandments.

11 For disobedience bringeth damnation, offending the guiding Spirit until repentance intercedes and restores.

12 For I am a merciful God, otherwise none could stand.

13 Where are a people to do My will? Behold I have looked in vain; therefore, I must bring about circumstances that will cause My people to repent, for they are drunk with the fatness of the land.

14 But I will make the fatness lean, and the pleasures a hedge. And where there is prosperity, there shall be poverty, and where there is security there shall be fear.

15 Would that they would heed My word in their prosperity, but pride taketh their hearts, for they think that with their own hands they have gained their prosperity.

16 Behold, all that now stands shall fail, yea even your great banks and lending institutions, your great corporations that make of the employee a slave, yea and the governments that support them.

17 Will ye then set up My holy order or perish?

18 Behold I say unto you My son: ye are but one, but will yet make of thee a multitude.

19 For those who say they believe, yet do nothing, are liars and those that say they believe, yet heed not all My words, deceive themselves, and shall eventually fail.

20 Until I have a people that are willing to forsake all of Babylon, behold I say, Zion cannot be established.

21 Therefore repent My little ones; harden not your hearts that ye may be saved in the Kingdom of your Father.

Even so, Amen.

SECTION 26 – October 29, 1978

...

75 For how can ye reap that which ye have not sown?"

76 And when the people of My church find out that they have sold their souls for naught, behold they will become angry and say, "Can we not redeem our souls?"

77 But the LORD will say unto them, "Ye cannot redeem them, for you were warned in many ways by My true prophet, and you heeded him not, and cast him out, and listened not unto his warning, and the false prophets ye heeded are now gone and have received their reward, and how then can ye redeem your souls? Behold ye have your reward."

78 And there will be weeping and wailing and gnashing of teeth.

SECTION 27 – About 1974

...

4 Behold I say unto you, that no wife is of value to a righteous man unless she is totally dedicated to the upbuilding of the Kingdom of God, for if she has her own ambitions, she is a hindrance rather than a blessing to that man, and it would be well for that man to be rid of her before he too becomes entangled with her selfish desires.

5 This can apply to both male and female, but the woman must be guided by a righteous Priesthood holder to help her make the right decisions.

SECTION 46 - September 15, 1968

...

43 And behold Mine anger is kindled against the women who are called to step forth to raise up a righteous generation; and the lamentation I gave unto My servant Steven is correct, for they step not forth and deny their sign and witness and are damned.

44 Behold I say unto you, that the time will shortly come to pass that all that they now comfort themselves in shall be taken from them, even their mansions and their vehicles; and their fine apparel and their jewelry and gold will avail them nothing.

45 And they shall see all their sumptuous living taken from them in an instant.

46 And they shall lie upon the ground for want of a bed; and they shall fear that which cometh in the night; and they shall weep and wail all the night long, for their children shall be driven through and they shall be ravaged and torn.

47 And where there was once a sweet smell there shall be a stink; and where there once was a girdle and stomacher, there will be a rent.

48 And their fine hair and coiffures shall become as a tanglement; and they shall find no comfort in all the land.

49 For they shall suffer as they have caused My servants to suffer.

50 For the daughters of Zion step not forward to stand beside My holy prophets, but instead are ashamed of them and accuse them of all manner of iniquity.

51 For they seek the praise of the world and are ashamed of Mine holy covenants.

52 Blessed are those few who step forward and take the hand of the prophets and are led by them, for they shall be as Eve; but cursed are those who step not forward, for their cup shall be empty; and only if they are brought down to the depths of hell will they learn obedience.

53 For they rejoice in a man of deceitful lips and turn their backs on the choice men of the earth whom I have called.

54 Oh you blind and stupid daughters of Zion, for ye repent not, neither will ye hearken; and because ye neither repent nor hearken, ye shall be brought low, even unto the depths of humility by that which ye suffer.

55 For a time soon cometh that seven women shall take hold of one righteous man and say, "Behold we will eat our own bread and wear our own apparel, only let us be called by thy name to take away our reproach."

56 And even then ye shall be as servants only, begging for that which ye receive and subservient to those who are worthy of a much greater weight of glory.

57 And I have called many to be wives unto My servants the prophets, and what have they done?

58 Behold, after they have received a sign and a witness, the adversary hath come before them with sweet words and they have been deceived, for they desired the things of the earth rather than the joys of Eternal Life.

59 And they have lifted up their heels against My Servant and accused him of iniquity when there hath been no iniquity, for he hath done only what I have commanded, and none else.

60 And those who cry iniquity, behold their hopes will be blasted, and the arm of flesh on which they rely shall fail; and all will be desolation and ruin, for I will not suffer My servants to be mocked longer.

61 And it hath gone forth in a decree from My throne that justice be enacted in behalf of My faithful servants.

SECTION 54 – February 6, 1980

...

12 Yet women flee to the arms of the wicked, seeking comfort and ease, and they desire possessions and recognition from the world.

13 They seek not for Life Eternal, and cast their inheritance from them as if it were a dirty rag.

14 And I give unto them a sign and a witness, and they trample it under their feet as the swine walloweth in mire, and turn and rend My servants.

15 Behold I say unto you, what reward shall they have, and what sorrow will they suffer? Even so, Amen.

SECTION 147 – September 1988

...

38 And ye shall prepare yourselves for many important things to come, for ye need not think that ye will escape sacrifice, neither will ye escape trials, neither will ye escape persecutions, for I will prove all who are Mine.

39 For those who are Mine are willing to sacrifice all for My sake.

SECTION 148 – April 1989

...

12 For a woman is of no value unto a man unless she actively supports him in all his righteous desires.

13 For a woman who is passive and permissive is of little worth unto a man and is even unto him a great burden. For as he is totally dedicated in the building up of My kingdom so shall she also be dedicated.

14 Even then will My work progress upon the Earth.

15 Behold I say unto you, here is wisdom: heed it and dedicate thyself unto Me, and behold, nothing shall be held back, for so am I bound by My Word.

16 For have I not said, "Seek ye first the Kingdom, and all things shall be added unto thee as they are needed"?

SECTION 83 – September 15, 1982

Thus saith the LORD unto My Servant. Behold the leaders of My church have lost My holy priesthood in that they can no longer function in it.

2 Yet they still retain it to pass unto someone worthy, but this they will not do, for they believe they still retain it even as Ham would claim it from Noah, yet he lost it because of transgression.

3 They likewise have lost it because they heeded not My commandment to reinstate the marriage laws, that the brother would take his fallen brother's wife and raise up a posterity unto him.

...

20 But they soon shall be visited with the whirlwind and their false peace shall be destroyed, leaving them naked.

21 Shall there not then be weeping and wailing and gnashing of teeth?

SECTION 78 – April 1982

...

11 For this reason must I bring forth and establish My Zion, that a place be prepared for these choice spirits that they be not corrupted by the filth of Babylon.

12 Then when a woman opens up her heart and gives it completely to a man of God, that woman opens up the sealed portion of heaven where the more righteous spirits dwell which will become the children of righteous Abel.

13 The spirits will then be released unto that family, and that family protected and hedged up unto Me, and they shall be adopted by proxy unto the family of Abel so that his posterity finally come forth.

14 Yet the seed of Cain desires this not to happen, for he doth know that it hath been decreed that they shall be servants and serve the seed of Abel forever.

15 And will not that then be just? For I am a just God and reward every man according to his works.

16 And this I say unto all men that they repent and prepare themselves in humility, preparing their minds and bodies as chosen vessels of God.

SECTION 53 - January 1980

...

10 For have not I said that Mine anger was kindled against Israel, for the daughters of Zion walk haughtily before Me and sell themselves for naught.

..

13 Nevertheless, the prophecy concerning the daughters of Zion hath been fulfilled, for they all walk haughtily before Me, and few have humbled themselves to where they are of much value unto the children of men, most of them being like unto them a millstone about their necks.

14 And they hold their children up and make, as it were, each of them a chain of mail and a coat of brass across their shoulders, and instead of a joy, a great burden.

15 What then can they be likened unto? Salt that hath lost its savor, good for nothing but to be trodden under foot of men, for such will surely happen.

SECTION 121 – June 17, 1985

...

6 So was it the same with Mine ancient prophets, for few found women uncontaminated, and they followed after the traditions of their fathers and of the world, and thus they were unable to lead them by the hand to the Celestial spheres.

7 For they saw only the immediate rewards and pleasures and if these desires are not forthcoming, they desert My servants and seek to those who can provide them with these things.

8 And thus Mine ancient prophets were made to be alone and some had to flee that their lives be preserved.

9 Thus My soul weeps for the daughters of Zion who sell themselves for naught; and it is oftentimes better for My servants to flee from these women rather than have them continually lead them to do evil and bring upon My servants much condemnation and sorrow.

SECTION 96 – June 21, 1983

...

19 And because they repent not and gather not to the places appointed they shall be mowed down with the wicked, for I cannot separate the good from the evil except they gather.

20 Behold I say unto you there is no other way.

Even so, Amen.

SECTION 108 – May 1984

...

12 For I say unto you, the greater sin is to sin against the Spirit and it is worthy of death, for their cup of iniquity is full and they repent not, no matter what calamities I bring against them.

13 For this reason I will destroy utterly those who have known Me and yet now deny My holy prophets, for they have chosen prophets of their own liking, which heap upon them praise and vainglory.

14 Nevertheless, I will spare those that repent.

15 Yet few will repent, for they are bound with great fetters, having faith in the arm of flesh which will fail and cause their utter destruction.

SECTION 77 – March 20, 1982

...

8 For I give unto no man the blessings of the Kingdom unless he makes an effort to obtain them.

9 For a man must desire the Kingdom at all costs, otherwise he shall fail.

10 For a slothful servant shall not reap the same reward as one who sacrifices all for My name's sake.

11 Behold My son, I am not a God of concession nor a God of compromise.

12 I reward a man only when he has sacrificed all for My name's sake, how else then can he overcome all things?

13 If he is taken in a snare over a small matter, how then can he survive the more severe testing, even of a broken heart and a contrite spirit?

14 Thus I strip a man of all that he has, that perhaps he will repent.

15 Yet will he learn by it? I say unto you, he will not humble himself because his pride be in his way.

16 What more then can I do, for a man must seek after righteousness with all his heart to obtain it, for it can be obtained in no other way.

17 Some say they love Me with all their heart, yet make Me their enemy by blocking out the Spirit of Truth, for they really love darkness rather than the truth and light of the gospel.

SECTION 60 – About 1973

...

11 For if a man or woman resisteth My Spirit by disobedience, it shall be replaced by a spirit which is not of Me but of a different source that leadeth not unto salvation, but leadeth a person carefully into forbidden paths.

SECTION 56 - March 1980

...

6 For it must needs be that I reinstate all the laws of Israel that they be a schoolmaster to bring My people into the Celestial realms.

7 For without the law they cannot progress and receive My Spirit, for only in this way can it be obtained.

8 So taught My early prophets shortly after I was taken from the earth, but those who read their words stating that they should live by the Spirit felt that the law was done away.

9 But I say unto you, ye cannot gain the Spirit unless it is by obedience to the law.

10 This they misunderstood, thinking the law was no longer necessary.

11 Behold I say unto you, the law which is eternal must be lived in order to gain the Spirit, and when the Spirit is gained the law becomes no longer necessary; and then ye shall live by the Spirit, but not until.

12 And if ye then rebel against the Spirit, ye must return to the law until the Spirit be regained.

13 Yet the law that was lived by the Jews at the time of My coming was not My law, saith the LORD, for it was a corrupt law made up of My laws mingled with the laws of men.

14 And therefore it was this vessel that was to be broken to pieces, for it no longer contained the living waters and it could no longer be repaired, for it contained too many errors.

15 For none could have understood the direction after the correction be made.

16 And it was this law that was to be done away and replaced by the new vessel, even the New Testament.

17 Yet, but a few years passed by before the waters of this vessel were also filled with filthiness, and I had to spew it also out of My mouth.

18 Therefore, the laws were again lost from the earth.

19 And I sent My servant Joseph Smith to reinstate these laws, but he was martyred before he could bring forth a particle of them.

20 Nevertheless, he restored many truths, but again the vessel hath become filthy.

21 Behold I say unto you, it must needs be cleansed, for even so I have promised, and none shall stay My hand.

SECTION 58 – April 23, 1980

...

28 When will ye step forth and do the will of the Father given through My holy prophets?

29 For if ye will not heed the words of the vessel, will ye then not heed the creator of the vessel, even the potter?

30 For the potter createth the vessel for his benefit.

31 For the vessel containeth the living waters, and if they reject the vessel they also cast aside the Word of God.

32 Oh that men would repent and come unto Me and lay their burdens or sins at My feet, or in other words, through faith in Me abandon their sins.

33 For I am ready to forgive all that they may be free indeed, for without repentance there is no progression or salvation in My kingdom.

34 And many do procrastinate the day of their salvation unto their damnation.
